The meeting of DIALOP with Pope Francis

Rome, 10.01.2024. A delegation of 7 Marxists and 8 Christians was invited to a private audience with Pope Francis 10 years after the historical meeting with Alexis Tsipras (former PM of Greece), Walter Baier and Franz Kronreif, 10 years after Laudato Si, 10 years after the start of the pontificate. A true milestone! The Pope talked to the group for twice the allotted time in a friendly and warm atmosphere, listening to questions and comments. He told the group that beyond being a 'moral value', solidarity is a "demand of justice which calls for correcting the distortions and purifying the intentions of unjust systems, through radical changes of perspective in the sharing of challenges and resources among people." He encouraged our group to be open to new paths and to break the mold of our thinking through dialogue. "In a time marked at various levels by conflicts and splits, let us not lose sight of what can still be done to turn things around," he said, asking to work "against rigid approaches that separate people". <https://www.vatican.va/content/francesco/en/speeches/2024/january/documents/20240110-dialop.html>

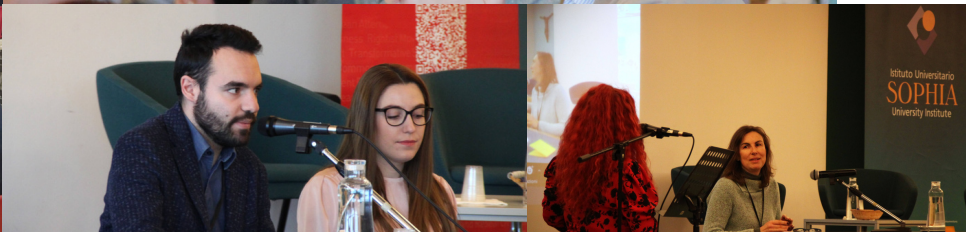
INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON INTEGRAL ECOLOGY FOR A SOCIAL
